What would you do if you lost your vision from a work-related injury?

The most common hazards to the eyes and face are:

- Chemical irritants and corrosives
- Dust and dirt blown around by the wind
- Flying particles from drilling, cutting, digging, and woodworking
- Splashes
- Radiation from welding and electrical work

Protecting your eyes – control hazards at the source:

- Utilize protective screen and wire mesh at the source
- Utilize the eye protection shields installed on machines
- Control dust and fumes using general ventilation systems
- Always wear the proper eye protection!

Remember, protect your eyes – do *not* risk losing your sight!
