Bishop extends precautions due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Venice - Most Rev. Frank J. Dewane, Bishop of the Diocese of Venice in Florida offers Parishioners prayers and guidelines to minimize spreading of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Florida and in the United States.

In January, Bishop Dewane encouraged Parishes to temporarily discontinue to the distribution of Communion of the Precious Blood during the Mass and discouraged Parishioners from holding hands during the Our Father, and shaking of hands during the Sign of Peace, in order to minimize spreading the flu.

As the Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to spread in the United States and including Florida, these precautions will be continued, and a new list of recommendations have been issued to Pastors and Administrators of Parishes pertaining to the reception of Holy Communion by mouth, emptying of the Holy Water fonts and exercising extra vigilance in cleaning and sanitizing frequently touched surfaces.
