¹All Catechists and School Teachers must complete Basic Certificate in Catechesis in the first year of employment or volunteering

²All Catechists and Religion/Theology Teachers **MUST** complete the Intermediate Certificate in Catechesis within two years of employment or volunteering.

³ALL Catechists and Religion/Theology Teachers **MUST** complete the Advanced Certificate in Catechesis within five years of employment or volunteering.

⁴Professional Certificate in Catechesis holders are exempt from Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced Certificate requirements.
