MARY FRAN CARROLL NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Now accepting applications for the 2017-18 academic year.

Purpose: The Catholic Community Foundation is proud to offer adult learners, who have been out of high school for three or more years, the opportunity to obtain a college degree or vocational training through the Mary Fran Carroll Scholarship. Ms. Carroll was a woman of deep Catholic faith, who wanted those receiving her scholarship to benefit from her legacy by being better prepared to face the challenges of the world today and the ages to come, in addition to using their education for the betterment of the entire community.



Award: A total of three \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded this year for tuition, books and fees (housing and living expenses not eligible). Scholarships may be renewed annually up to a total of five academic years for students maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.2 on a 4.0 (unweighted) scale. *Members or relatives of the Catholic Community Foundation staff, Board of Directors, or Scholarship Committee are ineligible to apply*

Deadline: All applications and supporting documents must be submitted electronically by 5:00 p.m. on July 28, 2017

Eligibility:

- Residents of Sarasota County, FL who have been out of school for 3+ years with serious financial circumstances that prohibited them from pursuing their educational objectives;
- Completion of FACTS application and financial needs assessment;
- Attend a course of study leading to a particular career, which must be described in a clearly articulated career plan;
- Acceptance into an accredited college, university or vocational program;
- Academic performance;
