Standards and Procedures for Safe Environment Training for Children

- The Diocese of Venice uses the VIRTUS curriculum for the Safe Environment Training of Children up to the age of 18. Teachers/Catechists/Youth Ministers have the option of using one of two lesson plans for each grade level. The four-year cycle of lesson plans has been purchased by the Diocese. The lesson must be presented in the classroom during a regularly scheduled religious education or youth ministry session.
- 2. To access the lesson planning materials, go to www.virtusonline.org. The user id is venicepcl and password is dov2011. Read Step 1, Step2, and Step 3. Download the Touching Safety Program Overview for parents and other materials as appropriate for each step. Click Continue. The Touching Safety Select an Age Group screen will display. Select the grade level desired from the drop down box. Click Continue. The Touching Safety Select a Lesson screen will display. From the drop down box, select the desired lesson and click Continue. The lesson plan page will display. Click the green arrow to download the lesson plan. A new tab will display. Print the lesson.
- 3. Parents may not attend any Safe Environment Training of Children. However, the *Touching Safety Program Overview* is to be provided the parents prior to the training session. Use of supplemental speakers from local law enforcement agencies, child protection agencies or representatives from the Florida Department of Children and Families is encouraged.
- 4. All children participating in religious education or youth ministry either at the parish or at a school must complete the annual Safe Environment Training for Children by **December 1**st **of each year**. A make-up session will be completed by **March 1**st **of each year** for any child absent from the initial training. The training schedule is as follows:

- 5. The sessions are mandatory and as such, parents may not allow their child(ren) to "opt-out" from participating in the session.
- 6. Directors of Religious Education must train catechists, and youth ministers using a lesson plan from VIRTUS to insure effective instruction by youth ministers and catechists. Principals and DRE's must review lesson plans and approve speakers.
- 7. Each parish/school designates a local Safe Environment Coordinator who maintains all parish Safe Environment Records.
- 8. The local Safe Environment Coordinator completes and submits an annual report of the number of children trained during the year to the <u>Department of Education no later than March 31st of each year</u>. The number of students is listed on the Safe Environment Training Report also includes the number of catechists/teachers fingerprinted and safe environment trained.
